

IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING STATE OF OHIO ASSESSMENTS APRIL 3 – MAY 10, 2019

The following is important information concerning the required state testing that our students will take in April and May. The State of Ohio requires that students participate in these assessments as part of their graduation requirements.

Which students are required to test?

- Students enrolled in the following courses will be required to test:
 - English 9B and Honors English 9B
 - English 10B and Honors English 10B
 - Algebra IB
 - Geometry B or Honors Geometry B
 - Biology B or Honors Biology B
 - American History B
 - American Government B

To provide the optimal testing environment, we will follow the adjusted schedules listed on the reverse side.

❖ Testing will occur on the following dates:

- English – April 3 & 4, 2019
- Algebra I – April 24, 2019
- Geometry – April 25, 2019
- Biology – May 1, 2019
- American History – May 2, 2019
- American Government – May 2, 2019

- ❖ Please try to avoid appointments during these testing times.
- ❖ All students involved in testing are to report to school by the regular start time of 7:50 am.
- ❖ Students are expected to be on time for testing, and **attendance is mandatory**.
- ❖ Students who are not required to test and would like to arrive to school at the delayed start time, will need to provide their own transportation to school. **Busses will run on their normal schedule on these testing days.**
- ❖ Students who are not required to test and take the bus, should report to the cafeteria for study hall during the testing window.
